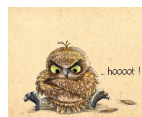
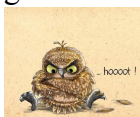
Auxiliary Donations to Ridge Meadows Hospital Foundation

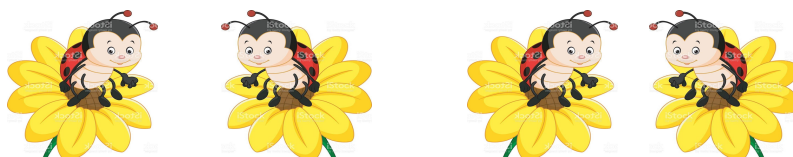
Great News

From BC Provincial Vancouver Island Auxiliary Advisor, PPMP Pat Irvine:

Hello Sisters, I would like to apologize for “forgetting” that I was the Vancouver Island Advisor this past year and as such was required to submit a report to the floor of Convention. I am especially sorry that I was unable to attend Convention in Abbotsford as I truly miss being with my “Eagle Family”.

The past few years have been difficult for us on the Island. First we lost Parksville Auxiliary and now it appears that we are also losing the Aerie and we have just recently lost Port Alberni Auxiliary. This leaves us with just six Auxiliaries; however, the Island Zone has over 700 members – the largest Zone in the Province. There are only 265 kilometers (just over 3 hours driving time) between Victoria and Campbell River, thus visitations between Auxiliaries are common as are dual memberships.

I receive many phone calls and emails from Sisters, not only on Vancouver Island, but also throughout the Province. Many of the questions are answered in the Rules and Regulations for the Government of Ladies Auxiliaries or in the Constitution and Statutes of the Aerie and in these cases I simply refer the Sister to the appropriate Section. However, there are times when I may be in doubt about the answer or my interpretation of the “rule” and I will attempt to get it clarified by the Grand Aerie/Auxiliary before I give a final response.

The most recent question I have received was in regard to dual memberships and whether a dual member who was a Past Madam President in another Auxiliary would be recognized as a Past President in her dual Auxiliary and have the same privileges. I referred the Sister to Section 1.7 (c) in the L.A. Rules and Regulations and Opinion 592-B under Section 70.5(c) of the Aerie Constitution and Statutes. Because I had some doubt as to whether the Sister would be included on the Dual Auxiliary’s Past Presidents’ Roll Call or honoured as a Past President at the Dual Auxiliary’s Anniversary Ceremony, I referred the matter to the Grand Auxiliary who simply quoted me the Sections of the rule books that I had already cited.

I would like to thank Sister Donna Roach for appointing me as Island Advisor this past year and Sister Klara Schubert for this year’s appointment. I appreciate the questions put to me particularly because it keeps me in touch and keeps my mind sharp!

Questions and Answers

Q – Does a re-enrolled applicant have to be interviewed and balloted on?

A – Yes, **Section 1.6** of the Rules and Regulations state in part; **All applications for Membership**, submitted by the applicant, shall, after having been read to the Auxiliary Membership, **be referred to the Interviewing Committee.** **Section 1.8** of the Rules and Regulations state; Any former member of an Auxiliary is eligible to apply for re-enrolled membership in any Auxiliary and all applicants for re-enrollment **must be interviewed and then voted on by secret ballot.** **Section 1.8 (b)** of the Rules and Regulations state; **Re-enrolled members need not be re-initiated.**

Q – Are we being asked to change our Ritual regarding the existence of a Supreme Being because of what the Aerie Ritual might say?

A – No, This was discussed at the Grand International Convention this July as there were Resolutions regarding this change submitted but were not brought to the floor because we were informed that the changes we were asked to make were because we were going against our Rules and Regulations **Section 1.2** and **Section 7.5.** **Section 1.2** of the Rules and Regulations states in part; **No person shall be eligible to be elected to membership in any Local Auxiliary unless such person is a female, is of good moral character, believes in the existence of a Supreme Being,** **Section 7.5** of the Rules and Regulations states; **The Ritual of the Ladies Auxiliary shall be considered part of the Rules and Regulations.**
