Good Afternoon my Brothers and Sisters; Hope you are all well and surviving this Co-vid ordeal. I hope that you have all heard by now that the 2021 BC Provincial Convention will be hosted by the Cranbrook Aerie and Auxiliary #3032 next June on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> to Sunday 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021. At this time I would like to give you a little information on the Convention.

The Auxiliary Headquarters will be at the Heritage Inn across the street from the Aerie Hall. All Auxiliary functions will be held at this place except the Joint Opening and Memorial which will be held in the Aerie Hall. The Memorial service will be held after sessions on Thursday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>. Aerie Headquarters will be at Aerie Hall as well as all Meetings; Lunch and Friday Night Joint Banquet.

The Heritage Inn is the preferred Hotel for your Convention convenience as it is in a close proximity to the Aerie Hall. As other events are happening in town at the same time, booking early would be strongly advised, there is a block of 25 rooms for Eagles Members. Room includes a Breakfast; Room rate at the Heritage will be \$109.25 per night.

## Questions and Answers

**Q - If a Past Madam President quits her Auxiliary then comes back would they still classed as a Past Madam President?**

A - Yes, **Section 6.4 of the Rules and Regulations states in part;** If any Past Madam President of any Auxiliary shall affiliate with another Auxiliary, or re-affiliate with her own Auxiliary after having ceased to be a member in good standing of the Ladies Auxiliary because of non-payment of dues, she shall upon such affiliation or re-affiliation be restored her former status of Past Madam President and the Auxiliary shall enter her name on the list of its Past Madam Presidents and shall be recognized as such.

**Q - If a Past Madam President resigns from her Auxiliary then comes back would they still classed as a Past Madam President?**

A - Yes, **Section 6.4 of the Rules and Regulations states in part;** However, any Past Madam President who has resigned from the Ladies Auxiliary shall not, upon re-affiliation, be restored to her former status of Past Madam President. Any Past Madam President who resigns from the Order shall rejoin as a new member and shall not regain her status as a Past Madam President. There are only two (2) prohibitions enumerated in the Rules against restoration of a Past Madam President's status upon re-affiliation. They are where a Past Madam President of an Auxiliary has been expelled or where she has resigned from the Order.

**Q - If an Officer has given an Excuse of Absentee can she then be marked as present and would she have perfect attendance?**

A - No, even though an Officer has given an Excuse of Absentee and at the meeting it was voted on and accepted, does not make her present at the time of Roll Call, she must be marked absent or excused.

**Q - Is it the duties of the Auxiliary Secretary is to write all Communications as directed by the Auxiliary, or can any member take it upon herself to write a letter on behalf of the Auxiliary, including any communications with the Grand Aerie?**

A - **Section 13.1 of the Rules and Regulations states in part:** It shall be the duty of the Madam Secretary to keep a full and complete record of the proceedings of the Auxiliary in a book provided for that purpose by the Grand Aerie or if the records are kept electronically, they shall be printed and read at each meeting and, once approved by the membership and signed by the Madam President and Secretary, copies shall be kept and protected in a three (3) ring binder or book for that purpose. It shall be her duty to read to the Auxiliary all reports, bills and communications which may be presented, including all official communications received from the Grand Aerie, which shall be read in their entirety unless otherwise specifically directed. The Madam Secretary shall assist in the transaction of the business of the Auxiliary, write all communications; fill out all certificates and cards granted by the Auxiliary; keep and maintain at all times a full, complete and up-to-date roster of the membership, committees, as required by the membership Management System (MMS) and officers of the Auxiliary with the latest up-to-date residence and mailing address and email address of each member and officer.
